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Frequently Asked Questions

How do I know if a micro wedding at Polished Party Place is right for me?

Polished Party Place (PPP) aims to provide couples with an elegant, memorable and affordable wedding, shared with their closest friends and family. Our venue may be small and a bit unconventional, but our high-end service and attention to details won't go unnoticed. Our goal is to make every person attending the event feel comfortable and celebrated. Read on for some more pertinent information regarding our micro weddings.

Decor

PPP has a wide range of decor options to match many different themes and color schemes. The couple will have the opportunity to meet with PPP staff to create their centerpiece design, tableware, and discuss the overall theme and look desired for the wedding. We are so excited to see your design choices using our inventory!

Pre-Ceremony

The couple will have access to the venue 90 minutes before the ceremony start time. Unfortunately, PPP does not have a getting ready space, though there is an area for the bride and bridesmaids to get dressed privately prior to the ceremony if necessary.

Rehearsal

PPP will work with the couple and wedding party the day of the ceremony to ensure all included in the ceremony know their role and understand the ceremony plan. PPP recommends that all members of the wedding party are present 45-60 minutes before ceremony start time, PPP will assist to ensure the couple does not see one another prior to the ceremony, if that is desired.

Ceremony

PPP micro weddings are officiated by our in-house ordained minister, however, couples are welcome to provide their own. PPP will assist with getting guests seated, guiding the couple and wedding party, and playing ceremony music via PPP's Bluetooth speaker. The ceremony is short, lasting about 10-20 minutes. The couple is welcome to recite their own vows, if desired. A unity ceremony/ritual is not typically included, but the couple may include one, if preferred.

Cocktail Hour/Reception

Following the ceremony, guests will be guided towards the bar area to order drinks. If appetizers are being provided by the couple, they will be available at this time as well. After guests exit the ceremony area, PPP will close a set of wall to wall curtains in order to 'flip' the ceremony set up into the reception space without being visible to guests. This process will take about 20-25 minutes to complete before reopening the curtains. Guests will then have access to the seating area at this time. If there are any guests who will need a seat during this 'flip', please let us know in advance, if possible.

Non-Alcoholic Beverages

PPP will provide non-alcoholic beverages as follows: Water, Ice, Lemonade, Iced Tea, Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite, Ginger Ale, and Root Beer. If desired, two soda options may be swapped out with a different soda variety, e.g., Mountain Dew may be substituted for Ginger Ale.

Alcohol

The couple is invited to bring their own alcohol if desired. PPP will provide a bartender. The couple is permitted to bring alcohol to PPP on a day prior to the event. The couple may provide as many different beers/wines as desired, but mixed drinks/cocktails are kept to a minimum of three. The three mixed drinks/cocktail options that will be offered must be provided to PPP at least two weeks prior to the event. The couple is responsible for bringing all alcohol, necessary 'mixers', and garnishes for the cocktail options. If any of the necessary 'mixers' are included in PPP's non-alcoholic beverage package, the couple does not need to provide those mixers. No shots of any kind will be served. Alcohol will only be served for a total of 4 hours for the event.

Catering/Desserts

Couples are invited to provide catering and desserts of their choice. Catering is best to be brought in one hour prior to the ceremony start time, as arriving during or even after the ceremony would be disruptive. Because hot foods will need to be kept warmed prior to dinner, PPP recommends choosing options that hold well - please consult with your caterer for best options. PPP has a hot box food warmer, that holds up to 5 full size chafer pans. Cold foods may be stored in our coolers until it is time for dinner. Caterers may drop and go, as the PPP staff will get everything ready for the buffet when it is time. For the buffet, PPP provides 3 full size electric steam table pans with covers. If more are needed for serving, the caterer or couple should supply. PPP also provides various serving utensils.

Photography

Although the couple is welcome to provide any photographer they choose, a typical wedding photographer may not be necessary due to PPP's location and venue size. While action shots may certainly be captured throughout the ceremony and reception, portraits will be much more difficult to capture inside our venue. Immediately following the ceremony, if desired, PPP could provide some time for group photos and some individual photos in front of the ceremony arbor and pretty chiffon draped backdrop, which will cover wall to wall 32 feet wide and nearly 12 feet tall. The couple could also break away with their photographer and visit some local outdoor areas for photos. Ultimately, PPP suggests explaining to any potential photographers the micro wedding style as it may be possible this could fall into a lesser priced photography package versus a typical wedding. Another option to consider may be to schedule an outing with your photographer on another day for the couples' wedding portraits - for this option PPP highly recommends [Amber G Co. Photography](#), located in Selinsgrove.

DJ

Couples may decide to provide a DJ for the event, however, it may not be necessary. A playlist could be provided to PPP and our staff could set up and play on our high-end Bluetooth speaker. Our staff can play your special playlist during dinner, play special songs for the first dance, parent dances, etc., and play your special playlist following dinner. Or the couple could certainly assign a friend to handle playing the music as well. However, if a DJ is desired for the event, PPP recommends letting them know that space is tight, and equipment/lighting does need to be kept to a minimum. We recommend a 2ft by 4ft table for the DJ to be stationed at, which PPP can provide if necessary. Uplighting should not be purchased/provided by the DJ, as PPP will provide.
